PAC Principal's Report for May 2018

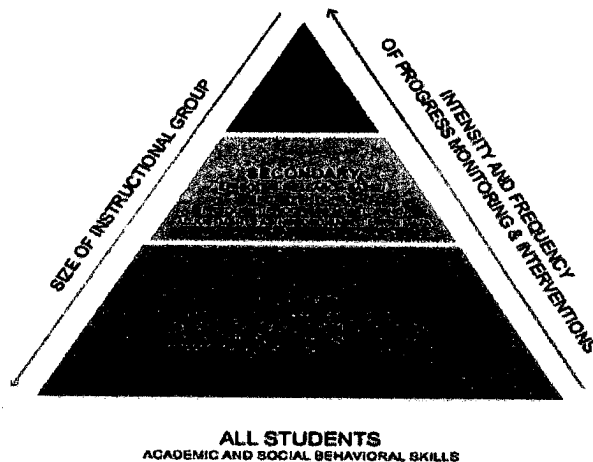
