• Laura Paiement, the district's Healthy School Coordinator did a presentation regarding Healthy eating, Healthy Relationships Active living and healthy practices including Sexual health.

DPAC wants to zoom in on Healthy Eating, Sexual Health Education and Drugs.

Sexual Health Community Partners are available
SAFE society (The Shuswap Area Family Emergency)
Provides many services such as community based victim services & sexual violence.
Police based victim services. - DPAC looking into bringing in community speakers on this issue.

Drugs- DPAC is interested in reaching out to parent community & connecting parents together in order to facilitate where we share info & discuss pressing questions & the consequences around kids & drugs especially with Constable Scott of the RCMP detachment.

Peter Jory - The school district has sent out a letter to parents to ask consent for your child to use 2 internet based tools; G-suite & Microsoft

office 365. In a way to track our kids progress paperlessly & to streamline the process of sharing files between teachers & students. A permission process with parents has started & they need parental consent for minors.

- The district has or will be hiring 8 new TIOC (Teachers Teaching On-Call) from the 94 applicants. 4 are trained as teachers, 2 have PHD's & have been university instructors and 2 have science degrees with extensive experience working with young people in a leadership capacity.
- The province has increased funding for teacher training and recruitment
- Mr. Ryan Brennan has been appointed as the new Human Resources Director. This position is designed for the purposes of managing assigned operations in accordance with district policies, procedures & codes.
- Carl Cooper: Outdoor learning school @ South Canoe update: City council has passed a motion to go ahead with reopening the school & will be opening Sept. 2018 for K-6. As of February there are 111 registered students.
- There is a parent information session regarding changes to bus routes + how it will impact families tonight (Apr. 11) @ 6pm @ Shuswap Middle School. Our school is not on the list of schools most impacted to changes.
