We create and support an environment where students are taught and practice self-regulation skills, personal and social problem solving and restitution.

Information and Discussion items:

Thank you for the Welcome Back BBQ: Lots of people turned out despite the rain. Beef was delicious!

- Parent Teacher interviews: feedback from teachers that they had about 85% of parents attend this afternoon/evening meeting.
- Rotary clubs: money for lunches (\$1000) Lori and I will purchase items to be used for forgotten lunches.
- Music program Update. We have a music instructor, Erika, (not teacher yet) who will be assuming all of our music classes late November. We have a temporary band teacher, Richard Creighton who is starting the band portion with grade 6/7/8 on Wednesday. Another teacher has (hopefully) been secured for k-5 music. This has been very frustrating for everyone as we have always had a strong music program and this year with dire shortages of teachers, it has been piecemeal but we hopefully are headed for a more permanent answer.
- Volleyball is underway with a mixed grade 6/7/8 team. Playing at Silver Creek October 30
- ADST (Applied Design Skills and Technology) each classroom

received wood working kits to build either a planter, a locomotive, logging truck, bird house. New curriculum is to encourage kids to build and design, test and adapt. Each kit is approximately \$200, grant from Career Department.

- One to One Reading: Thanks to Ashley Petkau for taking on the coordinating role of this amazing reading support program. Will begin reading with kids soon. Will need parent permission for those students going out to read with our volunteers.

- Outdoor Experiences Building Plan Update:

We discussed with all of our students what they would like to see on our playground to promote creativity, cooperation and fitness. They came up with incredible ideas and these are listed on the bulletin board near office.

Kitchen is in and carpentry table. Next step is bringing in large rocks, circular outdoor meeting circle, climbing wall against gym and sand box. We are looking for grants that we can apply for (Kirsten has applied for two, one rejection and waiting on second) to raise the money needed to purchase materials and possible some labour.

Kirsten meeting with Maintenance Director, Trevor Bettcher to discuss ground prep and get permission for some of these ideas.

Outdoor circle: Spring

Sandbox: Spring

Climbing wall: Spring

Other ideas such as a walkway/path out the end of the school grounds and rope and ladders structure need to have special permission to proceed.
